

**North Dakota Human Rights Coalition  
2005 Conference Scholarship Policy**

The North Dakota Human Rights Coalition (NDHRC) will award scholarships to individuals to attend the 2005 NDHRC annual conference, “Tools for Building Inclusive Communities: The Role of Human Rights Education and Action in North Dakota,” Thursday, October 27 and Friday, October 28, 2005 in Fargo.

The intent of the scholarships is to support youth and low-income North Dakota and Minnesota (Clay County) residents that cannot afford to attend the conference without assistance.

Pending funding, the NDHRC will award a limited number of scholarships to individuals who meet the following criteria:

1. Youth or low-income North Dakota or Minnesota (Clay County) resident
2. Working with or interest in working with individuals most likely to experience discrimination or diverse communities

The scholarships may cover up to the cost of the two-day conference registration and related accommodation expense. Travel stipends and assistance with childcare expenses will be considered upon request. To reduce expense, you may be asked to share a hotel room with one other person – no one will be asked to share a room with a person of the opposite sex.
