Presenters



Judge William Thorne is a Pomo Indian from Northern California. Back by popular demand, Judge Thorne currently serves on the Utah Court of Appeals and is president of the National Indian Justice Center. He has served as a tribal court judge in Utah, Idaho, Montana, New Mexico, Colorado, Arizona, Wisconsin, South Dakota and Michigan on a part-time basis for over 20 years; and he has also served as a full-time state trial judge for over 14 years.

Dr. Terry Tafoya, trained as a traditional Native American Storyteller, is a Taos Pueblo and Warm Springs Indian, and a Family Therapist at the Interpersonal Psychotherapy Clinic, University of Washington School of Medicine. With over 20 years of University level teaching experience, he also serves as a National Consultant for the U.S. Center for Substance Abuse Prevention, and is the Chief Curriculum Writer for the GONA. He is on the National Teaching Faculty for the American Psychological Association, and on the faculty of the Milton H. Erickson Foundation for Clinical Hypnosis and Psychotherapy.

Dr. Spero Manson is a Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center (UCHSC) and director of the American Indian and Alaska Natives Program at UCHSC. Born on the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa reservation, he has worked extensively in the area of research to provide information helpful to addressing the needs of American Indian people.
